Breast screening: the facts

For women without symptoms aged 50–69, a breast screening mammogram **every two years** is recommended.

Women in their 40s and 70 years and over, who have no breast cancer symptoms or signs, are also eligible for **free screening mammograms**, however they are not specifically targeted.

Having regular screening mammograms is the best way to find breast cancer early, before any symptoms are noticed and when treatment is likely to be most successful.
