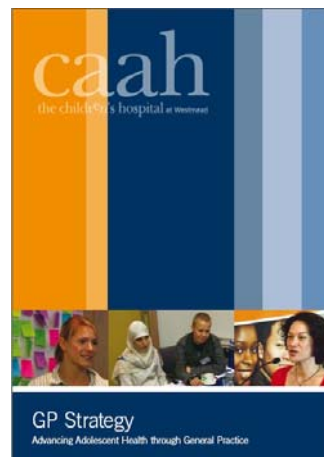
As part of NSW CAAH's GP Strategy and its commitment to supporting young people in NSW through General Practice, NSW CAAH undertook research exploring successful youth health programs run by NSW Divisions of General Practice (DGPs).

In March 2008, in collaboration with GP NSW, NSW CAAH hosted a NSW DGP Youth Health Forum entitled 'Making the Connections'. The Forum aimed to facilitate networking and information sharing between NSW DGPs to assist with the development of effective youth health access and education programs.
