2008–2010 RACGP QA&CPD Program requirements (Note: new or modified elements indicated in bold)		
<p>A minimum of 130 points is required for the triennium and must include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• two Category 1 activities from the options listed below, and</li> <li>• <b>completion of a basic cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) course.</b></li> </ul>
